Application along with documents should be submitted to the General Manager, District Industries Centre, Department of Industries, U.T. of DNH&DD on the web portal http://swp.dddgov.in to avail reimbursement/assistance. II. The UT RAMP Programme Committee (UTRPC) shall assess the applications, scrutinize and verify the submitted documents, and clearly recommend each application for approval or rejection of the claim III. Based on the recommendations of the UTRPC, the General Manager, District Industries Centre (DIC), shall issue the sanction order for disbursement of the approved subsidy. IV. Subsequently, the eligible subsidy amount shall be credited to the applicant's Loan or Cash Credit (CC) account through RTGS/NEFT. V. After submission of all required documents and satisfactory response to queries, the application will be processed within a maximum of 90 days from the date of submission of complete verified application. VI. In case of any discrepancies, the decision of the Union Territory RAMP Project Committee (UTRPC) will be final. VII. The Union Territory Administration reserves the right to change, withdraw, or modify the guidelines, either fully or partially, at any stage.
