NOTIFICATION

The U.T. of Daman & Diu is satisfied that for the rapid industrialization of U.T. of Daman & Diu, it is necessary to exclude boilers from certain provisions of the Boilers Act, 1923.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of section 34 of the Boilers Act, 1923 (No. 5 of 1923), the U.T. of Daman & Diu hereby excludes boilers which have been installed or which will be installed in future from the operation of the provision of Section 7,8,9,10,12,13,14, 15,16,17,19,20,20-A,21,22 and section 23 subject to the following conditions, namely:-

(1) Before the use of boiler, the owner of the boiler may apply to the General Manager, District Industries Centre (hereafter referred to as DIC) of the concerned district along with the following documents to have the boiler registered-

(a) As per the provisions of clause (c) of sub-section (1) of section 14 of the Boilers Act, 1923, all necessary documents as provided in regulation 4 of the Indian Boiler Regulations 1950 along with the applications for registration of the Boiler.

(b) A certificate from the "Boiler Engineer" with regard to the boiler for the period and maximum pressure for which it can be safely used.

"Boiler Engineer" shall be a person:-

(i) who is a graduate in Mechanical or Production or Power Plant or Metallurgical Engineering from a recognized institution;

(ii) has a minimum five years experience singly or cumulatively in the following fields related to boilers,—

- (I) Design;
- (II) Manufacture;
- (III) Commissioning;
- (IV) Operation and maintenance;
- (V) Inspection and certification during manufacture or operation and maintenance;
- (VI) High Pressure Welding Inspection; and

(iii) is registered with DIC as a "Boiler Engineer"

(c) Fees as prescribed in Rule 385 of the Indian Boiler Regulations, 1950.

- (2) Thereafter, an annual certificate from "Boiler Engineer", as given below shall be submitted to the "DIC" with regard to that boiler can be safely used at the pressure approved by the DIC for a further period of 12 months.



- (3) It will be responsibility of the owner of the Boiler to run and maintain it as per provisions of the Boilers Act, 1923 and regulations and rules framed under the Act and owner shall also be responsible for any violation of the provisions or accident.

- (4) The "Boiler Engineer" shall follow the provision of the Boilers Act, 1923, rules & regulations framed thereunder and shall be liable and responsible for any act or omission or commission committed against the provision of said Act, rules & regulations, including de-registration as "Boiler Engineer".

(5) If the owner of boiler violates any provision of the Boilers Act, 1923, regulations and rules framed thereunder or any of the above provisions, in addition to penal provisions in the Boilers Act, 1923, a penalty of Rs. 5000 shall be imposed on him. For any subsequent offence, besides penalty of Rs 5000, penalty of Rs 500/- per day shall be additionally imposed and/ or restriction can be imposed on the use of boiler. The General Manager, DIC shall be competent to impose the penalty or stop the use of the boiler. The owner may file an appeal with the Labour Commissioner within 30 days of the order passed by the General Manager DIC whose orders shall be final.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of section 34 of the Indian Boilers Act, 1923 (V of 1923), the Administrator of Daman & Diu and Dadra & Nagar Haveli hereby excludes the boiler and the steam pipes or steam pipe in the whole of the U.T.'s of Daman & Diu and Dadra & Nagar Haveli from the operation of the provisions of sub-sections (2), (3) and (5) of section 7, sub-section (5) of section 8 and section 12 and section 13 of the said Act, subject to the conditions and restrictions specified in the Schedule appended to this notification.

SCHEDULE

(a) The Boiler and the Steam pipes or Steam pipe shall be inspected every year by the owner as per the technical provisions of the Indian Boiler Regulations, 1950, by any of the following agencies hereinafter called as Third Party Inspection Agencies, namely:-



5. M/s. Japan Inspection Company Ltd.

(b) The Third Party Inspection Agency shall follow instructions and guidelines of the Chief Inspector of Boilers and shall be liable and responsible for any act of omission or commission committed against the provisions of the said Act and Rules and Regulations framed thereunder.

- (c) The Third Party Inspection Agency shall submit records of inspections carried out by them to the Boiler Inspector, Chief Boiler Inspector and Boiler Owner within thirty days of carrying out the inspection and preferably also on their web-site. It is clarified that on receipt of inspection report by the Boiler Inspector, the inspection report will be duly pasted in the Memorandum of Inspection Book by the concerned Boiler Inspector. It is further clarified that inspection by Third Party Inspection Agencies is optional.
- (d) Report of daily chemical analysis for feed water and blow down water should be submitted monthly to the Third Party Inspection Agency as mentioned in para (a) for scrutiny and Chief Inspector of Boilers for information.
- (e) Working pressure of the boiler shall not exceed that as specified in the last working certificate issued.
- (f) The Boiler shall be stopped immediately, if any accident occurs to the boiler or to any part of the boiler during this period and the Chief Inspector of Boilers shall be informed immediately.
- (g) The Boiler shall be attended by qualified Boiler Attendant(s).
- (h) This notification will be applicable to such Boilers and steam pipes or steam pipe having the safe guard system like protection against over pressure, low water level, flame failure etc. for prevention of accidents of boilers and provision of these safe guards shall have to be certified by the owner and third party inspector.
